The 2022 tax season is upon us. The summer, July 1, tax bills have been mailed and are due and payable July 1. The summer tax bill is considered past due after September 14, 2022 and late fees will be charged. Before paying a past due summer tax bill contact the township treasurer for the payoff.

The 2022 winter tax bill is due and payable December 1. The winter tax bill will be considered past due with late fees if paid after February 14, 2023. Before paying a past due winter tax bill contact the township treasurer for payoff.

You also have the ability to go on line to <u>www.bsaonline.com</u> to check your current tax balance. This amount does not include any late fees if your payment is past due. So, if your payment is past the due dates above, you will need to contact the township treasurer for the payoff amount.

The township treasurer will only be collecting year 2022 summer and winter taxes through February 28, 2023. Payments received after the last day of collection but have a post office date stamp on the envelope prior to the last day of collection will not be accepted. Those payments will be returned to the payee and they will have to get a payoff amount from the county treasurer's office.

All payments by check, money order, etc. should be mailed to Millen Township Treasurer, P. O. Box 145, Barton City, MI 48705. You can also take your payment to the Barton City Post Office in a stamped, addressed envelope to be placed directly into P. O. Box 145. The counter hours are 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Monday through Saturday. For cash payments you will need to contact the township treasurer for an appointment.
