2023 ROAD PROJECTS:

Stout Road

- Apply single sealcoat with fog
seal from M72 South to
Fowler Rd. (\$34,191.00)

Trask Lake Road

- Apply single sealcoat with fog
seal from Stout Rd. to
Sanborn Rd. (\$20,399.00)

Walker Road

- Apply recycled asphalt
millings to existing surface
from Sanborn Rd. east to Bean
Hill Rd. (\$34,461.00)

I wish to again thank the community volunteers that assisted with the park and cemetery clean up this spring. Again, thank you for a great effort by all to keep our township park and cemetery looking very nice. Great effort by all involved and the community is a better place for all of your hard work!

It is great to see our park and ball diamond being utilized by our community 4-H "T" Ball teams on Tuesday and Friday evenings. Please join the parents in watching these young athletes play ball on our ballfield.

We continue to make improvements in the park. We hope to get the pavilion re-painted yet this season. We have stained and sealed the 18 picnic tables in and around the pavilion. Also, we are in the process of getting bids for the removal of the four large oak stumps along the outfield fence that were left after the July 2013 wind storm. This will allow us to properly mow and maintain this area of the park.

Three road projects were approved this season. We continue to work with the Alcona County Road Commission to properly maintain our Township roads. The costs of material for these projects continue to increase, making it a little more difficult to do more expansive projects. We are doing the best we can with the available Road Funds.
