DISABLED VETERANS' FACT SHEET

- You will need veterans' current year letter from the VA. They only come out in November of each year.
- Copy of DD-214 (**only once**) if you have already filed once you do not need it again. If your VA letter under Military Information has the word Honorable in there then you do not need the DD-214.
- Starting with 2025 you will need to file your Form 5107 Disabled Veterans Exemption after January 1 and that will then be the last time you file this form. There will also be an audit (letter sent) every three years by the assessor that you will more than likely be required to return with questions that are asked and you have answered.
- If you are going to sell your home you must now file Form 6054-Request to Rescind Disabled Veterans Exemption within 45 days after either the individual ceases to use and own as a homestead the property for which the exemption was granted or the individual no longer meets the qualifications under MCL 211.7b with the assessor.
- If you just purchased your home, you will also need to send a copy of your closing documents to assist the local unit in determining the property tax obligations
